

## Drought Relief Assistance Scheme – Beekeepers (version 1)

The allocation of sugar to assist Queensland beekeepers is done on the basis that the Queensland Government wishes to support registered beekeepers maintain the welfare of their bees impacted by:

- Fire or by smoke in the environment;
- Burnt vegetation (no immediate food source);
- Drought (no immediate food source).

Beekeeper's hives are eligible for assistance with supplementation if they are registered QLD hives, managed by beekeepers from the State of QLD. Eligible beekeepers are able to pick up dry sugar from Hive + Wellness Australia's (HWA) Richlands, Brisbane facility, where many Queensland beekeepers or their colleagues visit regularly.

The individual beekeeper sugar allocation is calculated at a rate of 1 kg per registered hive per day for 7 days, and the allocation is provided on the basis of delivering 1 months' supply:

- Allocation (kg) = Number of registered hives x 1kg x 4 weeks (1 month);
- For example, for 100 hives, the allocation is = 100 x 1 x 4 = 400 kg;
- Sugar is supplied in 25 kg bags, 400kg is 16 bags.

Some information about your application, the location of your hives, drought-declared status, and impacts from a natural disaster or drought may be provided to the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries and Queensland Beekeepers Association the purpose of assessing eligibility for assistance. The Department of Agriculture and Fisheries may refer to your information recorded in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System to help assess your application for assistance and/or audit and review any assistance measures you have applied for under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme. Your personal information will only be used by authorised officers and will not be disclosed to any other parties without your consent, unless authorised or required by law.
